Submission Guidelines

Before starting a book proposal please send us a cover letter.

Cover letter tips

We invite you to *briefly* tell us about yourself and your project, including the following information:

- . Your experience and background in editing and writing (if applicable).
- . How you came to meet Mooji and the nature of this connection.
- . What you feel you can bring to Mooji Media.
- . A one or two paragraph summary which describes your project.

If Mooji gives your project his initial blessing, we may ask for a book proposal. The book proposal offers Mooji a clearer sense of the project, and will give Mooji Media a feeling as to how it will fit onto the current publishing schedule and what type of support may be needed.

Book Proposal Guidelines

During the early stages of creating a book not all of the following sections will apply to every project. However, we ask that you follow the outline as much as possible.

- 1. Title and subtitle
- 2. Length
- 3. Content

Overview (1 - 3 pages)

This is a description of the book's content and scope. What makes it unique? What benefits does it bring and what needs does it satisfy? How is it different to already published books? How is it structured?

Other questions you may consider: Will it centre around themes? Is it chronological? Is it progressive, gradually deepening? Include anything you feel is relevant.

Chapter Plan

This is a chapter-by-chapter synopsis. Please aim for 1 - 2 paragraphs per chapter to give us a sense of the content and progression of the manuscript.

4. Sample Chapters

We would like to see 3 - 5 sample chapters representative of the manuscript as a whole. If it is a book containing satsang dialogues, it is very important that you also include the raw (unedited) transcript with the place, date and time the satsang or spontaneous talk took place.

5. Market

Is this book an introductory text or for those already immersed in the teaching? Do you have a translation or particular country in mind? What is the size of the proposed market? Do you have any connections within that market? Include any information you feel is relevant.

6. Timeframe

When do you realistically propose you are able to deliver the final manuscript for us to review?

7. Additional Information

Personal Details

Full name, address and contact phone number

Previous Publishing Experience

This is not essential. If you have previously published books or articles, let us know about these. Also include any blogs and social media pages related to your work in the publishing industry, and the number of hits. Please keep this brief, preferably in bullet points which give the salient facts.

Heartfelt Dedication
